

TREK OVER THE TOP 2012

POLICIES

1. Passports/Customs

This is an international event for which you must possess a valid passport to participate. You are required to clear customs prior to the event. If you are not cleared by customs, your registration will be treated as a refund (See section 4 for details). You must present your passport to a Border Service Agent upon arrival in Dawson City and upon return to Tok.

2. Liability

Klondike Visitors Association (KVA), Alaska Trailblazers (AT) and the Dawson City Sled Dawgs are not liable for any accident, injury or death caused by participation in this event.

3. Safety

Each rider is responsible for his or her own safety; this includes provision of safety gear. Helmets are required in Canada by law. KVA and AT recommend that you always wear a helmet and ride safely. This event is for experienced, able riders, ride in groups and stay safe. Tow Sleds and skidders are not permitted on this trip.

4. Cancellation/Refunds/Transfers

- All changes (this includes cancellations, refunds or transfers or other exceptions) must be approved by KVA and AT.
- There is a \$50 charge for any change made to your purchase.
- No changes are allowed to your purchase after two weeks prior to event.
 - For the first run, deadline for changes is: February 15th.
 - For the second run, deadline for changes is: February 22nd.
 - Any change requested after this date will require documented military or medical proof and will be subject to a \$50 fee.

5. Age Limit

You must be 19 years or older to participate in Trek Over the Top. Any registration for or by someone under the age of 19 will be treated as a refund (See section 4 for details).

6. Convictions

If you have a conviction (this includes DUI) which prohibits you from leaving the United States or entering Canada your registration will be treated as a refund (see section 4 for details)

7. Drugs, Alcohol and Firearms

Drugs, Alcohol and Firearms are NOT permitted on the trip to Canada and back to the United States. Any rider caught in possession of any of these items will be subject to the full extent of the law.

8. No Shows

If you purchase a ticket to Trek Over The Top 2012 but do not attend the event, you will be charged the full amount of your purchase.

9. Hotel Rooms/Registration

The number of entrants you register is the number of people that will be in your room. Registrant agrees to policies on behalf of everyone he is signing up for the event. For example, if you sign up a minor or a convicted felon, you will be charged the \$50 change fee.

10. Other

These policies override the Central Reservations Policies of the KVA Central Reservations System.

In case of special circumstances or disagreement related these policies, KVA and AT reserve the right of final decision.
